This property is situated in the countryside without being isolated and close to a small village about 15 kms from Eymet.Old farmhouse on 7000m2 of land in the countryside but not isolated. Water and electricity coming into the land bounded but it is necessary to reset a counter. The old house has one room 21.5m2 with fireplace and old sink 1, 1 closet, tiled floor - originally a large room partitioned today forms a corridor 5m2, plus 2 pieces of 15m2 and 20m2. The soil of this part is terracotta. 2 other rooms with concrete floor 15m2 and 11m2 of covered an extension of the house. The barn of 76 m2 floor abuts and communicates with the house. The current owner has obtained the necessary authorizations for conversion into a dwelling.
