This property is situated in the countryside without being isolated and close to a small village about 15 kms from Eymet. Old farmhouse on 7000m² of land in the countryside but not isolated. Water and electricity coming into the land bounded but it is necessary to reset a counter. The old house has one room 21.5m² with fireplace and old sink 1, 1 closet, tiled floor - originally a large room partitioned today forms a corridor 5m², plus 2 pieces of 15m² and 20m². The soil of this part is terracotta. 2 other rooms with concrete floor 15m² and 11m² of covered an extension of the house. The barn of 76 m² floor abuts and communicates with the house. The current owner has obtained the necessary authorizations for conversion into a dwelling. The 75m² cellar floor is adjoining but not communicating with the other buildings. A former annex building in ruins is also located on the ground. All restoration work requires the structural work (roofs) and walls of some buildings, but there are many possibilities for lovers of old stones ...
