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Located just 5 minutes from the town of Bergerac, in the heart of the Dordogne Valley, this exceptional property benefits from proximity to UNESCO World Heritage sites and is just 1.5 hours from Bordeaux.

The estate is bordered by dry moats crossed by several bridges, adding charm and character. to the property. Two entrance pavilions harmoniously frame the main building and terrace, reinforcing the symmetry of the site.

A horseshoe-shaped staircase to the main entrance of the central building and the main entrance - 26m2

Main entrance and hallway 26m²

The kitchen, the heart of the house, this characterful kitchen, 7.9m x 6.1m ($48m^2$) with antique tile floors and exposed beams, seduces with its conviviality and functionality, featuring an impressive stone fireplace for cozy evenings.

Fully equipped with all modern conveniences, a professional double oven, six hobs, a Smeg Falcon gas cooktop, extractor hood, slate worktop with a built-in sink, a central slate island with overhead heat lamps, and a large wood-burning stove.

Back kitchen/pantry, 5m², terracotta tiled floor.

A large dining room of $44m^2$, generously sized (7.7 x 5.7m). Its terracotta floor.

Bathed in natural light thanks to two French windows, the dining room opens onto a rear terrace. An interior door provides direct access to the living room/games room, creating a beautiful flow between the living spaces.

At the front, wide double doors lead to an interior terrace/hallway of 30 m^2 (16.5 x 1.8 m).

Scullery/pantry, 5 m², terracotta tiled floor.

Rear terrace 31 x 6 - 186 m²; 132 m² of lawn, 54 m² to the south.

BBQ area, tiled floor, stone, open fireplace, sink.
