

A long path leads to this equestrian complex, bordered by fields and fenced pastures, with a few bodies of water in the middle.

Comprising a Périgord-style house, a barn, and horseriding facilities, this facility is ready to welcome you for teaching, breeding, or private stables.

It features:

- A 95 m² house with three bedrooms (15 m², 12 m², 12 m²), a 54 m² living room with an open kitchen and a fireplace enclosed by a wood-burning stove, and a 4 m² bathroom.

The attic space is convertible.

A basement houses the "Géminox" oil-fired boiler and hot water tank.

Aluminum double-glazed insulation.

Two terraces.

The roof was redone in 2025 with a current ten-year warranty.

- A 35 m² studio comprises a living room, a 30 m² open kitchen, and a 4.73 m² bathroom.
- A 73 m² Clubhouse with bay windows serves as a reception or client reception area, with a bar, showers, toilets, and an 18 m² private office.
- A 28 m² garage or workshop could easily be converted. It has a window.
- A barn of approximately 80 m² is used for fodder/straw storage.

For horse riding, there is:

- An 18 m diameter lunging ring
- A 70x20 m sand arena entirely covered with photovoltaic panels, which is fenced, and a stable area.
- -A building consists of a 42x20 m riding arena with a sand floor (requires little watering) with indoor stables of 25 3x3 m stalls, all equipped with automatic drinking fountains.

The frame is made of glued laminated timber.









As many stalls could be rebuilt, a central corridor could be used for the farriery, with a drainage channel.
