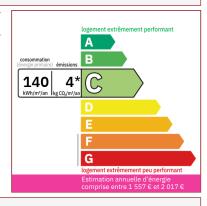

Located 30 minutes from Cahors in a small Lotois village in the Greater Cahors region, where life is pleasant in peace and quiet, this property was designed, conceived, and considered to be functional and economical. It offers a mainly single-story layout with 240m² of living space, requiring no work. It has been renovated with high-quality materials and surrounded by outdoor terraces.

An additional floor of the same size, 240m², awaits renovations to create additional bedrooms and bathrooms. It is built on a plank, and all water and electricity connections are planned, with rooms lit by portholes.

The materials on the ground floor are elegant and of high quality, carefully chosen: marble on all floors, oak parquet floors in the bedrooms, high-end double-glazed aluminum frames, most of them high-performance sliding (very thick tiles), custom-made cabinet doors...

The house is composed as follows: an exterior driveway welcomes us and reveals its facade adorned with a magnificent bull's-eye window. The rounded porch shelters us, offering a covered entrance to discover a cabinetmaker's door opening onto a spacious 48m² entrance hall that leads to the main living areas. Storage cupboards are provided under the upstairs stairs, as well as a closet hiding the water heater and electrical panel. A pellet stove, with its distribution vents, heats almost the entire house and dominates the center of the room.

Then, through custom-made doors, we discover a 43m² living/dining room with a perfectly functioning multi-flame fireplace for optimal comfort. Continuing on, a library welcomes us and could be a living room or a bedroom of over 34.87m².

All of these floors are marble, and light streams in through high-end aluminum bay windows with access to the outdoor terrace. Everything is extremely bright! There is also a 20m² kitchen with a terrace for meals with friends on summer evenings.

Then there are two bedrooms with beautiful oak parquet floors, measuring 20.84m² and 18.88m², one of which is a master suite with its own 14.37m² bathroom, and a second 5m² bathroom, also on the ground floor. There is a separate toilet.
