Equestrian property comprising:

- a recently restored stone house, offering on the ground floor: a fitted kitchen (23.8 m²) (gas hob, extractor hood, oven and microwave, dishwasher) opening onto a living/dining room (32.1 m²), a heated veranda (18.03 m²), a wide hallway (12.1 m²) leading to two bedrooms (12.9 m² and 11.6 m²), each with its own private bathroom (6.7 m² and 5.3 m²), and a toilet with a washbasin;

Upstairs: a landing, three bedrooms (13 m^2 , 9.3 m^2 and 11.4 m^2), and a shower room (5.4 m^2) (sink, shower, and toilet).

Oil-fired central heating. Aluminum double-glazed windows and a wooden double-glazed Velux window upstairs.

- Attached and connected to the house: tiled garage (50 m²), laundry room (10.8 m²), boiler room (10.8 m²)
- Barn of approximately 700 m² with 5 horse stalls, tack room, kitchen, hay shed, and workshop.
