The original tower was flanked by a more recent building, probably dating from the late 18th century. On the upper part of the land, which overlooks it, a terrace offers views of the park and the planted area of the property.

The house comprises an entrance hall of approximately 15 m², a living room with a monumental fireplace. The exposed roof truss leaves the ridge over 6 meters high, with a small mezzanine.

Fitted kitchen, office of approximately 27 m², bathroom, and one bedroom.

Upstairs: four bedrooms and a shower room.

The tower, which can be left private, houses two bedrooms with a staircase and a door separating it from the rest of the charterhouse.

Outside, there is a vaulted cellar, the former basement of a building that no longer exists.

Contiguous land of approximately 15 hectares, with a pond fed by a spring.

Garage for cars and equipment.

Oil-fired central heating.
