

The property features 5 spacious bedrooms, a dedicated office, outbuildings, and a recently built 10m x 5m heated saltwater pool—all set within beautifully landscaped grounds.

Interior Features:

Upon entry into the property, you are welcomed by a spacious hallway with travertine flooring and a guest cloakroom.

The fully fitted kitchen is a dream for food lovers, with a central island and granite worktops, double ovens, an Aga cooker, dishwasher, large refrigerator, wine chiller fridge.

The dining area, with its wood-burning stove and open fireplace, opens directly onto the garden via large French doors.

The sitting room features another fireplace with woodburning stove, travertine flooring, and garden access, creating a warm and inviting space.

Throughout the home, double glazing and wooden shutters ensure excellent insulation and comfort.

First Floor:

A beautiful wooden staircase leads to the 27 m² master suite, complete with herringbone oak parquet flooring, a Juliette balcony overlooking the countryside, a roll-top bath, en-suite bathroom with Italian shower, double basins, Wc, and a dressing room.

Two further bedrooms with oak flooring and interior shutters share a family bathroom with walk-in shower.
