The second floor offers two additional beautiful bedrooms with dressing rooms, a shower room with WC, and a living/office area overlooking the patio.

A charming medieval pedestrian alley separates the main house from its garden and outbuilding. The outbuilding houses a fully equipped summer kitchen, a separate bedroom with a shower room, sauna and separate WC, as well as a garage/workshop.

Additional features include double-glazed windows, stunning exposed beams, and a water softener.
