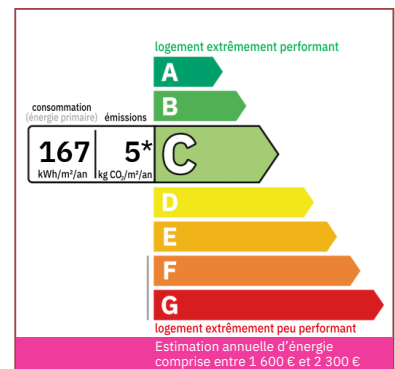

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Authenticity and high-end finishes define this superb fully renovated Perigord-style property, restored with remarkable attention to detail.

Blending period charm with modern comfort, the property showcases exceptional quality materials throughout, including travertine stone, solid oak flooring, traditional terracotta floor tiles and exposed beams.

A long driveway leads to the house and its barn, offering peace, privacy and a truly tranquil setting. Positioned within more than 1.65 hectares of grounds, the property enjoys beautiful countryside surroundings.

The ground floor offers a bright and flowing layout designed around the outdoor living spaces. The entrance opens onto a beautifully appointed kitchen and dining area of 46.23 m², which forms the true heart of the home.

The bespoke kitchen, created by a renowned high-end kitchen manufacturer, features a central island, range cooker, premium granite worktops, a traditional Belfast sink, integrated dishwasher and further quality fittings. The original terracotta tiled flooring adds considerable character and warmth.

A wooden staircase leads to the first floor.

Adjacent to the kitchen is a practical utility and pantry room with Belfast sink, together with a separate WC.

The 26.77 m² sitting room is warm and inviting, featuring solid oak flooring, exposed beams, an efficient wood-burning stove and reversible air conditioning. Wooden double-glazed doors open directly onto the terrace.

The principal suite provides a wonderful private space comprising:

- An entrance area with French doors opening onto a terrace
